

April 15, 2009

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town hall. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. Forbes was absent. The meeting was officially noticed.

Nelson made a motion to approve the April 1st, 2009 minutes. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Scott Bernette from the Grand Rapids Fire Department gave the first quarter report. They have done 4 car accident calls and 1 structure fire in the Town.

The new business permit for Marshall Krebs was not discussed since there was not representative in attendance.

Bob Sawyer from Saratoga Cranberry did not need a commercial permit for the shed that he is building since he is considered agricultural not commercial.

Nelson made a motion to accept the contract with Dan Hansen for his building inspector services. The contract will be enforce until one of the parties would like to make a change or terminate the contract. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to amend the beverage license for Octane Bar and Grill to include a 80 X 150 outside area right off the east end of the building. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to grant a special camping permit for Octane Bar and Grill for May 23, 2009. The event will be a Make A Wish ride. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Nelson made a motion to adopt Ordinance 4-15-09, Ordinance to Amend Ordinance 2-19-03 - All-Terrain Vehicle Route Ordinance. The route would now include 16th Street. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

The 50/50 road aid petition was signed and sent to the County.

Passineau made a motion to grant the operator's permit for Robert Tuttle. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. Doug LaBarge will be given two weeks to have the rest of vehicles off of his property on Hwy 73. If they aren't cleaned up, he will be given a ticket. Eugene Dahlman on Townline Road will be give 30 days to clean his property. David Keith on Hwy 73 has two weeks to clean his property. Mark Kocher has 2 mobile homes on his property, a second citation will be sent.

Linda Foley gave the Treasurer's report. Barb Fischer would like a refund of the garbage and recycling fee for one of her properties. Only one property has a home, the other just has a shed on it. The board okayed returning the garbage and recycling fee for the property with just the shed.

Correspondence was read.

Nelson made a motion to approve the bills paid. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

The board audited the Town books.

Passineau made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.
