

April 16, 2014

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Heeg made a motion to approve the April 2, 2014 meeting minutes. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

The building at the transfer site was discussed. It needs new siding and a roof. The only thing it is used for is for men to sit in for drop off days 2 days a month April thru October. They would be fine with a smaller building. Passineau made a motion to tear down the existing building and look for a smaller portable shed up to \$1500. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Staci Christianson gave the EMS report. July 26, 2014 is their Ride 4 Life fundraiser.

Forbes made a motion to have John Jansen evaluate the groundwater analysis from Golden Sands Environmental Impact Study submitted to the DNR. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Linda Tavener from Rangeline Road would like the Town to compensate her for extra moving fees. She said that the moving semi is not able to get into her driveway because of the steepness of the driveway. Since the driveway exceeds standards the Town will not compensate her.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report.

Correspondence was read.

Jason O'Keefe has a shop at the corner of Hwy 73 and Hollywood. There are constantly items within the road right of way impeding the vision of people trying to turn, which is very dangerous. There is racing engines and tearing tires quite a bit. A letter may have to be sent to have him come into a meeting to discuss how to fix the problems.

Notice was sent to the Town from the Advanced Disposal about an increase in garbage collection fees by \$.20 a month for each property. They have an increase in disposal fees that they are passing on to the Town. The Board is not pleased with this because the budget has already been approved with a contracted amount. The Clerk will check into the increase.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:05 p.m.
