

August 21, 2013

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. Heeg was absent. The meeting was officially noticed.

Frank made a motion to approve the August 7, 2013 meeting minutes. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

John Franz, Rome Fire Chief, spoke to the board about a current fire contract. He met with surrounding fire departments and they discussed automatic aid. With automatic aid, if there was a structure fire within the Town of Saratoga a page would go out to each of the fire departments and all of them would respond right away. He is not concerned about the boundaries right now, especially if the automatic aid goes into effect. He will talk to his board about drawing up a 10 year contract with the Town that will be the same as we have had in the past.

Frank made a motion to approve the Certified Survey map for Dan Hafenbredl. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

There is a 500 foot section of utility lines that need to be buried further in the ground around Lexus Lane. Alliant Energy will re-bore the utility lines in that section. Washouts on Young Street were fixed by Wood County.

Brad and Pat Pavloski were not able to make it to the meeting. The weed harvesting on NEPCO will be postponed until the next meeting.

The board reviewed amendments to the fee schedule. Frank made a motion to approve Resolution 08-21-13; A Resolution Amending the Fee Schedule for the Town of Saratoga. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report. She has spoken to the lawyer about the unpaid personal property for Wisconsin Pridestone. They are selling assets to pay their bills. He said that it will just be a matter of time before we are paid. The board will need to decide what to do with Spranger's unpaid personal property.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the Building Inspector's report.

Correspondence was read.

Passineau made a motion to approve the bills paid. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

The Board audited the Town books.

Forbes made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Frank seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:55 p.m.
