

December 16, 2009

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town hall. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Passineau made a motion to approve the December 2, 2009 minutes. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Nelson made a motion to appoint election officials for 2010-2011. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to appoint Terrance Hoffman to the planning and zoning commission. He will fill the vacancy opened when Lee Breeze resigned. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Nelson made a motion to grant the operator's license for Alisha Edgerly. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Jeff Glaza at 845 St Hwy 73 South for Classic Log Homes requested to get more time to get the structure finished. He said that he can't finish the building at the location he plans to move it to because there isn't enough room. He would like to work on it this winter with the help of two to three other people. He said that he only has to go up 2 more courses; then has to put the floor joist above that. He does not want to build another structure after he finishes the current one at the property. The board wants him to keep his business there, they would just like the structure removed; since they have had many complaints about it. The structure is not a danger, he keeps the lot clean, he just needs to stick to what he says and finish the structure. Frank made a motion to grant a business permit until September 15, 2010. He must have the structure removed by that time. If he does not have the structure removed, he will receive a citation. If he has the structure removed, he may come to the board to renew the business permit. Nelson seconded it. Forbes voted no. Motion passed.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. Complaints have been received from residents about Eugene Dahlman's property. He has built two large buildings to store his vehicles in. He has moved some of the cars to different locations on the property; many next to the road. A letter will be sent to Eugene to come to a board meeting to discuss plans for the clean-up of the property.

Kocher pled guilty at court. He was issued a fine from the day of the 4<sup>th</sup> citation until the time he was in compliance. The fine was \$365.00.

Complaints have been received about Jesse Scheid's property. He has been getting tires brought in. He has thousands of tires piling up at the property. Dave will check and send a warning letter out.

A Storm Water Management Plan must be submitted to the DNR by December 31, 2009 for the work that was done on Adams Avenue. The board agreed Passineau may hire someone to draw up the plans.

Correspondences were read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed. The

meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
