

December 2, 2009

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town hall. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Kathy Palm gave the First Responder's report. Elections will be held every three years for the EMS officers. The Nekoosa Lions donated \$250 to the EMS Department. The next meeting will be on December 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m.

Forbes made a motion to approve the November 18, 2009 minutes. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

The board and the building inspector, Dan Hansen, discussed the house at 9598 Cty Rd Z. The house is owned by Michael Regan. A stop work order was sent by certified mail and was signed for. No work has been done and no one has heard from the owner as far as his intent. A raze and remove order will be sent out. If no one hears from the owner again, the board gave Dan Hansen the authority to refer the case to the Towns' attorney.

Michael Osborne, 9047 St Hwy 13 South, requested to have his building permit amount lowered. He built a canopy before he got a permit from the Town, so the permit fee doubled. The building inspector has extra calling and work to do when a permit is pulled late. Forbes made a motion to keep the fee doubled since it was late. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Jeff Glaza at 845 St Hwy 73 South for Classic Log Homes received a citation for not having a business license. He came to the board to request a business license that wouldn't expire and he wanted to be able to finish his structure, which would include another level on top of what he has currently. He didn't know when he would have the structure finished. He received a two year conditional license in 2005, stating that he would have a model home on the property. In February 2007 Jeff was issued another 2 year permit. Although the board had received complaints about the log structure on the property sitting unfinished; Jeff told the board that he would have the structure finished or close to it before the license was up for renewal. In May 2009 Jeff told that board that he would like to finish the structure and then remove it to his property outside the Town. Jeff told the board that he should have it out by November. The board gave Jeff until November 15<sup>th</sup> to have it removed or a citation would be sent.

Forbes made a motion to deny the request for the business license. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to grant the operator's license for Sanya Bernal. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. Roger Riddle is renting from Barry Newlun. He has junk starting to accumulate on the property. Dave sent him a 30 day clean up letter. He was told by the board that he can not bring recycling materials into the Town and put it behind a fence. It is against Town ordinance to bring junk into the Town and he does not have a business license to do recycling. He told the board that he should have his property cleaned by December 11, 2009.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report.

Correspondences were read.

Nelson made a motion to approve the bills paid. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Nelson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Frank seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
