Kathy Palm gave the First Responder's report. Their next meeting is on February 25th at 6:30 p.m. Their Ride for Life fundraiser will be September 19, 2009.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report.

Linda Foley gave the Treasurer's report. Garbage and Recycling will be refunded to several town residents that do not have houses on their property.

Correspondence was read.

Passineau stated that the board and roadmen will need to get together to check the roads and bridge to be fixed this summer.

Nelson made a motion to approve the bills paid. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.
