The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town hall. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. Forbes was absent. The meeting was officially noticed.

Nelson made a motion to approve the December 16, 2009 minutes. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

The board reviewed a contract for the precinct counter. They had no questions about the contract. It will be tabled until the next meeting.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. The cars at Eugene Dahlman's have been removed. He sent a letter to the board stating he would be at the January 20th meeting to discuss the clean-up plan. Jesse Scheid spoke to Chairman Rickaby about the tires on his property. He has been selling the used tires. He has removed about 600 tires so far and would like more time to remove the rest of them to a storage building. He would like to keep some tires at his property as advertisement for the business. The board will give him 30 days to remove all but 20-30 tires to be used as advertisement.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report. The following people will be refunded garbage and recycling money since there is no house on their property; Gerald Murray, Jeremy Rakowski, Ronald Fischer, Gordon Keyzer and Dennis Rodgers.

The Town was granted an extension for the Storm Water Management Plan from the DNR. A firm has been hired to complete the plan for the Town.

Correspondences were read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
