The dog was taken to a vet and she would like the Town pay for the vet bill. No owner has been found for the dog. The Town will pay the vet bill. Gene Dahlman still has junk and cars outside his property. His court date was postponed to August 19th.

Nelson made a motion to approve the bills paid. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.
