The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town hall. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Frank made a motion to approve the June 3rd and June 8th, 2009 minutes. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

The Town of Rome Board was present to discuss what portions of Adams Avenue would be taken care of by each Town. We have been waiting for Plum Creek to clear the right of way before more work can be done. A written agreement will be made between the two Towns stating that all brushing, maintenance and plowing for Adams Avenue from 14th Avenue to 10th Avenue Street would be the Town of Saratoga. All the brushing, maintenance and plowing for 10th Avenue to 7th Drive, including the intersection at 10th Avenue would be taken care of by the Town of Rome.

Kenneth Hancock, 6820 64th St, requested a fence permit. The fence was 25 foot off the lot line. Nelson made a motion to grant the permit. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Lee Spencer, a representative for Mike Zurfluh, requested that 8 lots be added to the south west corner of the PIRCO Mobile Home Park. The board stated as long as he follows all DNR, State, County and Town regulations he is fine with the additional lots.

Dennis Hill, 5830 Broadway, requested mobile home permit. He has the required information and the mobile home is only a few years old. Forbes made a motion to grant the permit as long as the septic was up to code. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.
