Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report. Brian Renz has purchased 40 acres of land off Blue Ridge Lane and wants to get an address tile. Emergency Government is telling him that he needs to have a soil test done. He only wants to camp on the property occasionally, and does not plan to build on the property for some time. The board would like for the property to have an address tile, even without the soil test. If there was an emergency on the property, emergency vehicles would be able to find the property then.
