

March 17, 2010

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town hall. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. Forbes was absent; excused. The meeting was officially noticed.

Nelson made a motion to approve the March 3, 2010 minutes. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Members from Heartland Farms were present at the meeting and requested that there be a public meeting about them purchasing over 6,000 acres, so they could speak to the public. The board stated that they would have to have a public hearing if they were interested in the purchase; to change the land designation in the Comprehensive Plan. The Chairman requested that on the next agenda they discuss whether they would like to have a public meeting specifically over the Heartland Farms purchase.

Jeff Glinski, 5911 David Dr, requested a new business license for Glinski Plumbing. He will only store his goods in his garage. He does not plan to have anything for people to buy at his property. Nelson made a motion to grant the license. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Bruce Dimick, 5821 Church Ave, requested a new business license for Custom Furniture, and woodworking. He does not plan to spray any lacquers. Frank made a motion to grant the license. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Nelson made a motion to grant the One Day Beverage license for the American Legion. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Transfer site hours, days a prices will stay the same as last year; from 9-4 the 2nd and last Saturdays of the month, April thru October.

Frank made a motion to donate \$100 to the Wisconsin Rapids Safety Patrol. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Nelson made a motion to accept Certified Survey Maps for Thomas Thorison, Jan Ratzlaff, and William Milkey. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to adopt Ordinance 3-17-10; An Ordinance Establishing Conditions for Maintaining a Class B Beer/Liquor License in the Town of Saratoga. It permits the Town to revoke a license if an establishment is not open for enough days of the year. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

The board discussed the Seven Mile dam on Rangeline Road. The Town will have to apply for applications to remove the dam, notify the public and have an abandonment plan. Jewell Associates gave the board a proposal for doing all the paperwork. The board will discuss it further at the next regular meeting.

Frank made a motion to grant the operator's license for Cheri Ramker. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

The board discussed carport structures. The Town of Grand Rapids allows one structure on the property that must be maintained. This item will be postponed until the next regular meeting.

Dave Ryan gave the Constable report.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report.

Correspondences were read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
