

March 18, 2009

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town hall. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. Forbes was absent. The meeting was officially noticed.

Frank made a motion to approve the March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2009 minutes. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Nelson made a motion to grant operator's licenses for Ashley Normandin and James Saack. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

The board discussed the transfer site for 2009. The roadmen will look at fixing or replacing the building that is at the transfer site now.

**Metal and Tires**

The transfer site on County Road Z South will be open the Second and last Saturday of the month, April thru October, from 9:00 A.M. until 4:00 P.M. for the collection of metal and tires.

Identification will be checked.

The transfer site will accept up to 10 passenger or light truck tires 17 inches or less per address, per year, with no fee. Residents owning more than one property in the Town will only be allowed 10 tires total free of charge, any over the 10 will be charged. Business address will not be allowed to bring in tires free of charge.

All other tires:

\$3 per tire for passenger and light truck tires 17 inches or less, over the 10 per address limit.

\$3 per tire for any racing slicks, ATV, Garden Tractor and motorcycle tires

\$10 per tire for tires that are from 17 inches to tractor trailer tires

\$15 per tire for farm tractor tires

All tires taken are at the discretion of the Town employees at the transfer site.

The Notice of Claim from Plum Creek was tabled until the next meeting when all the members of the board get a chance to read the document.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report.

Linda Foley gave the Treasurer's report.

Nelson was concerned about clearing of the County line with the Town of Rome. We are still waiting for Plum Creek to clear the trees out of the right of way. The stakes may have to be replaced. They may have been knocked down over the winter. The roadman will call Plum Creek to see when they will be cutting.

The board signed the Donna Mae Creek 1<sup>st</sup> Addition subdivision plat.

Correspondence was read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Frank seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
