The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town hall. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Nelson made a motion to approve the May 5, 2010 minutes. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to approve the one year contract with Nekoosa Auto Iron and Metal for picking up metal and other items from the transfer site. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to appoint Dan Forbes, Tom Grygo, and Terrence Hoffman to the Plan Commission for a length of 3 years. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Forbes made a motion to adopt Ordinance 5-19-10; Ordinance to amend the Building Code Ordinance. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Dave Ryan gave the Constable's report. Barry Newlun pled not guilty for junk that was on his property. He had a renter that he evicted that was making the mess. He has since cleaned up the junk. The board will drop the ticket, but he must clean-up behind the church. Jesse Scheid paid his ticket, but he has not cleaned his property. Another ticket will be sent.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report.

Passineau resubmitted the Bell Road Bridge at a cost of \$400,000. The Town may have to purchase a half acre from the DNR for the project. Work on the abandonment and installing the culvert under Rangeline Road at Seven Mile creek is being done.

Correspondences were read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Nelson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
