

May 5, 2010

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town hall. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Frank made a motion to approve the April 21, 2010 minutes. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Don Tracy, 507 State Hwy 73 South, requested a fence permit. The fence was already installed. He installed the fence two foot off the property line. Frank made a motion to grant the permit. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Aaron and Gordy Wipperfurth, 5221 State Hwy 13 South, requested a new business license for sellrapids.com. They rent a spot out to someone interested in selling an item. Frank made a motion to grant the permit. Forbes seconded it.

The board discussed metal and items that Nekoosa Auto Iron and Metal could pick-up from the Towns' transfer site. They would be able to bring a shorter roll-off to the transfer site, so people could throw their metal items into it. They normally charge \$10 for each refrigerant unit, but in exchange for the metal items, they wouldn't charge the Town for the refrigerant items. A one year contract will be drawn up between the Town and Nekoosa Auto Iron and Metal.

Nelson made a motion to approve the Certified Survey Map for Paul and MaryAnn Roberts. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

The Wisconsin Rapids City Band was asking for a donation from the Town of Saratoga to sponsor a concert. Passineau made a motion to grant \$100. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Charles Buchs-Hammonds gave the EMS report. Epi-pens are now carried by the EMS members. They are not able to use them until it is approved from the Nekoosa Ambulance.

Dave Ryan gave the Constable's report. The Town of Saratoga does not have any ordinance dealing with chickens. If neighbors are having problems, it is a civil matter.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report. One hundred sixteen letters were sent out to people that have not received a dog license. They will have to let the Treasurer know if their dog has passed away, if not, they are responsible for a \$15 late fee for each dog not yet licensed.

There will be only one meeting in June. It will be held on June 2, 2010

Correspondences were read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Forbes made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Frank seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:54 p.m.
