

October 6, 2010

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Passineau made a motion to approve the September 15, 2010 minutes. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Kelly Slusser gave the EMS report. They are receiving donations from the Rapids Rafters and the Nekoosa Lions for helping out at the food stands. The next Ride for Life fundraiser will be held July 30, 2011. Proceeds from 2010 Ride for Life are going to be used to purchase new radios and jackets as needed. The board will look into the non-profit statue for the EMS department.

The property at 4930 Mill Avenue was discussed. The board would like to follow through with the condemnation and razing of the building on the property, even if the property would be sold to a different person. The issue was tabled until the board has looked into what step is to be taken next.

Forbes made a motion adopt resolution 10-6-10; Resolution amending the 2010 budget. It transfers money we had left from the 2009 budget into the 2010 budget. Nelson seconded it. Motion passed.

Nelson made a motion to rescind the motion made on August 18, 2010 to borrow money from Nekoosa Port Edwards State Bank for the 2011 budget. Forbes seconded. Motion passed.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. A letter was sent to owner and renter at 1164 Pixler Court regarding the junk on the property and a ticket was sent because of unlicensed dogs on the property.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report. A list of MFL properties were given to the Board members. These are the properties that the Board will not place the fire fee on the taxes. If a fire starts on these properties and fire trucks are called, they would be charged by the truck and man power by the hour.

Correspondence was read.

Forbes made a motion to approve the bills paid. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

The Board worked on the budget for 2011.

Frank made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 9:15 p.m.
