The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Passineau made a motion to accept the minutes with corrections for October 5, 2011. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Scott Bernette, Grand Rapids Fire Chief, gave the third quarter report. They were paged to 6 calls in the Town of Saratoga.

Chad Krug requested a new business permit for 556 State Hwy 73 S, for alternators and starter repair. Passineau made a motion to grant the permit. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Forbes made a motion to approve the liquor license for Nancy's Antique Nook located at 9041 State Hwy 13 South. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Forbes made a motion to pay \$44.45 for a bill received from Linda Tavener for a repair to her vehicle due to road construction. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Forbes made a motion to amend the 2011 budget. It moved money left from 2010 budget to the 2011 budget. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Kathleen Mancil, 10830 Oak Ridge, requested to have a Stocor container at her property. She wanted to use the container as permanent storage. The board informed her that is against Town ordinance.

Frank made a motion to accept the changes to the preliminary plans for South Shore at Nepco Lake. Changes included road configurations, the intersection at the Y camp and 12 lots instead of 18. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

They are also interested in the Planned Unit Development information the Board was considering to put in the building code ordinance. They will let the board know of any changes they would be interested in.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the Building Inspector's report. She has issued 13 permits since she has started. She will be changing her hours for the slow season soon. She will only be in the office on Wednesday nights and Saturday by appointment.

The Board discussed TRIP. They will try to get the grant for Young Street. They expect the project to be for the 2014 construction season.

Correspondence was read.

Heeg made a motion to pay the bills. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
