The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

The Board has been asked for years why the Town does not have a fire department and how much it would cost to get a fire department going.

Jewell Associates gave a presentation on their Fire Feasibility Study to the Board and people present at the meeting.

The Town will have to decide whether to keep contracts with adjoining Towns like we currently have or partner with one of the fire departments. The Town would have to get proposals from each of the fire departments that are interested in the partnership to see if it would be advantageous for the Town.

A meeting was set for March 7 at 6:00 p.m. to meet with Jewell Associates to draft a proposal we like each fire department to fill out and get back to the Town.

Passineau made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Frank seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 6:55 p.m.
