

January 4, 2012

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. Forbes was absent. The meeting was officially noticed.

Heeg made a motion to approve the December 21, 2011 minutes. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to change the minutes from November 16, 2011. In the building inspector's report, the word fence was changed to lean to. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

The board discussed billing back residents after an assessor's plat is done. Currently there is one that will be done on Townline Road. According to State Statute 70.27(1) the amount charged back to the resident has to be based upon the assessed value of the land only. Passineau made a motion to bill property owners according to the assessed value on the land only based upon the State Statute. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. John Sweet was present at the meeting. The board would like him to try and keep making progress. His property will be checked in the spring. Charles Osborne's property is cleaned up. Jesse Scheid has about 20 tires out on his property now, so he is in compliance.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the end of the year report for building permits.

Engineering is being done for Young Street.

There is still no light on the cell tower behind the town hall, which is very dangerous for helicopters for emergencies. A request will be sent to the cell tower company to be present at a meeting.

Poles are in the ditches on Townline, 48th and 52nd Street. Alliant Energy is going to be putting flags out to mark each pole.

Correspondence was read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Heeg made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
