The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:25 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Passineau made a motion to approve the September 19, 2012 meeting minutes. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Jeff Anderson, 10511 Rangline Road, received a letter from the Constable that he needed to clean up the un-registered cars and car parts from the property to finish his clean up.
