The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Heeg made a motion to approve the closed and regular October 7 & 19, 2015 meeting minutes. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the EMS report. March 12, 2016 will be their St. Patrick's Day Dance. The Nekoosa Fire Department has been working on the fire trailer. They will be housing the trailer. Glucose meters were donated to the department.

Mardi Meyer requested a business permit for Prim Patina for 7630 St Hwy 13 South. It will be moved from its current location at 8641 State Hwy 13 South. The Plan Commission recommended the move since it is a commercial property plus it is handicapped accessible and has better parking. Forbes made a motion to approve the business permit for 7630 St Hwy 13 South. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Heeg made a motion to grant the beverage and cigarette license for The Store at 9630 Hwy 13 South. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Passineau made a motion to adopt Resolution 12-21-15; Ordinance to Opt-In for Category B IOHs, Category 1 Ag CMVs, or the trailering of one of either of these two types of vehicles from farm to field, from field to field, or from farm to farm, to comply with the statutory axle weight limits under ss348.15(3)(b) pursuant to ss348.15(9)(f)2. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Forbes approved the 4 year road work plan, which is based on the road rating system. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Tony Berger, 830 Townline Road, was requesting a dealer's license renewal. He might sell a few cars on the south end of the property. He would like to keep the vehicles out of the corner of Townline and Hwy 13, since it is hard to see. He would be willing to cut the hill down if okayed through the DOT. Forbes made a motion to approve the dealer's license. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.

Frank made a motion to allow the Protect Wood County Group to use the hall free of charge for November 11, 2015. They will be using it for a public meeting about the water testing results. A representative from the University of Wisconsin will be leading the discussion. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed.

Lorelei Fuehrer gave the building inspector's report. Lorelei is the zoning administrator and she will receive 80% of the fee paid to the town for a conditional use permit.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report.

Billie-Jo gave the Treasurer's report.

The Towns' old tractor is being sold on Wisconsin Surplus.

Seven Mile at Hollywood Road was plugged up by beavers. It was unplugged over the weekend.

Correspondence was read.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed.
