The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Heeg made a motion to approve the minutes for December 7, 2016. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

There was a request to have a street light installed on Camilla Court. The Town has a street light installed on Yorkshire Court and Highway 73. The resident is able to install a yard light and contract with the utility company. Forbes made a motion to deny the request. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed 5 to 0.

Frank made a motion to approve the operator's license for Jennifer Stadler. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed 5 to 0.

Passineau made a motion to amend the 2016 budget to include \$33,850 to the revenue and \$33,850 to General Government expense. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed 5 to 0.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report.

Correspondence was read.

Passineau attended the groundwater protection meeting organized by Wood County. There was one potato grower in attendance. The group would like to develop a public policy.

The board would like the sign removed from the right of way of Nature's Way as soon as possible.

Frank made a motion to approve the bills paid. Heeg seconded it. Motion passed 5 to 0.

Frank made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed 5 to 0. The meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
