The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed.

Passineau made a motion to approve the June 1st, 2016 meeting minutes. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed.

Bids were opened for the TRI-D project on Bell Road. Passineau removed himself and abstained for conflict of interest. Forbes made a motion to accept the bid for 1 ½ " crushed aggregate for \$25,169.20 and pulverizing for \$12,320.64 from Construcks Materials and Excavating. Frank seconded it. Motion passed. Heeg made a motion to accept the bid for American Asphalt for asphaltting and shouldering for \$106,833.80. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Dave Ryun gave the Constable's report. Four more properties have removed items within the right of way. He will continue with the compliance of the remaining properties. Ken Jaecks case will be at court on the 22nd.

There is another mile that needs to be re-constructed on Bell Road. It will be bid separately from the TRI-D portion of the project. The bids will be opened and possibly acted on at the next meeting.

Billie-Jo gave the Treasurer's report. Five day tickets were sent to 30 dogs owners in the Town.

Correspondence was read.

Passineau has found a company that will do training of Town employees at a more reasonable price. He will continue to get more information and see if other municipalities in the area would like to join in the training to get it at a lower cost.

A bid was submitted to the Town by Country Disposal for garbage and recycling pickup starting January 1, 2017. The Board would like business references. If he is unable to provide them, since he is just starting out, they would like to get personal references.

Passineau made a motion to approve the bills paid. Frank seconded it. Motion passed.

Heeg made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed. The meeting adjourned at 7:22 p.m.
