The Saratoga Town Board met at 1:30 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed May 18, 2017.

Bob Kryshak, the Town of Saratoga's attorney, and Argil Jackson, owner and agent for Crossroads Tavern, were present for a Public Hearing regarding the reissuance of the liquor and beer license.

The Town of Saratoga sent notice to Argil letting him know that the Town intended to revoke his Class B liquor and beer license. The building at the property was torn down approximately in 2001 and the license has been issued to that address ever since. The Town has an ordinance that says if the license is not used 120 out of 180 days the town has a right to revoke or not renew the license.

Argil Jackson and Heidi Kawleski, Town Clerk, were called as witnesses.

The Board deliberated and made the decision to revoke Argil Jackson's license for Crossroads, pursuant to the Town's ordinance 3-17-10.

Forbes made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed 5 to 0. The meeting adjourned at 1:54 p.m.
