

June 6, 2018

The Saratoga Town Board met at 6:00 p.m. in the town office. Chairman Rickaby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The meeting was officially noticed on June 1, 2018.

Heeg made a motion to approve the minutes for the May 16 and 30, 2018 meeting. Forbes seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Jason Joling and Scott Young from Wisconsin Rapids Fire Department gave the Board a report for 2017. There were 211 emergency calls from Saratoga last year and they were able to go to all of them without needing to use mutual aid. The Saratoga EMS have been able to get their certification hours with the monthly training that they have organized. The Town has been receiving a \$10 stipend for every call that a Saratoga EMS shows up to.

Sam Heeg accepted an award the Fire Department and the Saratoga EMS received together. They were awarded the American Heart Association's Mission Lifeline EMS Bronze Award for implementing quality improvement measures for the treatment of patients who experience severe heart attacks.

Tim and Carrie Steinke were not present at the meeting. Their driveway waiver was tabled until the next meeting.

Christopher Austin requested a new business permit for 6421 Hwy 13 South, Wisconsin Rapids, for Austin's Pitt Stop. He wants to have a casual diner with seating for about 20 people. He knows that he will have to go through the State and Wood County to get the building up to code for the change of use of the building. He will also have to go through Saratoga's Plan Commission for site plan review. He is not able to get a full lease from the land owner unless he gets Town Board approval for the business. Passineau made a motion to grant the license contingent he gets all proper State and County, and Town Plan Commission permits and approvals. Frank seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.

Janice Ticknor, 8031 Hwy 13 South, was requested a 12' high wooden privacy fence to block the abutting Solarus owned property. Passineau spoke to a representative, Rick Schumutzer. Rick said that if Janice would pay for different fencing material to cover the existing metal fencing, they could change what is there currently. The material should provide 100% coverage so she would not be able to see the rolls of orange wiring that Solarus needs for work in the area. Janice discussed other possibilities of things she could do if the new fencing cover did not look as nice as she would like. Janice's conditional use permit money will be returned since she is not having a hearing on the 12' wooden fence.

Tim Giebert, lawyer for Leo and Catherine Piatz, 6540 Hwy 13 South, sent a letter to the Town regarding their property. The Piatz's have until June 14th to submit a clean-up plan to the Town. If the plan is not received, the Town will begin prosecution.

The Plan Commission's strategic planning survey will be sent out soon. To send the survey out in color will cost approximately \$1640.68. It will cost approximately \$1319.68 for black and white. Heeg made a motion to print in color to try to catch people's attention more. Passineau seconded it. Motion passed unanimously.
