

TOWN OF SARATOGA BOARD MEETING MINUTES

DATE: Wednesday April 19th, 2023

TIME: 6:00 p.m.

PLACE: Saratoga Town Office

PRESENT: Bryan Peterson, Josh McDonald, Chase Brockman, Lorelei Fuehrer, Roger Wilcox

This meeting was officially noticed on April 17th 2023.

Chairman Fuehrer called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

PUBLIC COMMENT: There was no public comment.

A written Constable report was provided.

No Building Inspector provided.

No Zoning Inspector report provided.

Supervisor McDonald and the Plan Commission are continuing to work on the zoning ordinance and will be having this draft ready for public hearing soon.

Supervisor Wilcox will be submitting minutes from the SPARKS and the PPF Committee to the clerk.

Paulette Weinfurter gave the clerks report. With the new members of the board she shared the 1 week deadline for an item to be placed on the agenda. She also requests that lengthy motions be written down to ensure accuracy.

Billie-Jo Kester gave the Treasurer's report. The \$15 late fee is being enforced for dog licenses. She is working on a report which will be given to the Constable.

Supervisor Brockman shared information on meetings and training sessions that are coming up from Wisconsin Town's Association.

Supervisor Peterson received a complaint on Lexus Lane and how rough the shoulder is. The Road Crew will look at this.

Supervisor Wilcox has been working with Doug Passineau and Kasten Kester to do repairs at the Town Hall. He also has been working with the Constable about a complaint on Aqua Drive. This will be referred to the DNR to investigate further. He had a discussion with a resident concerned about parcels of land being subdivided into smaller lots.

Motion (McDonald/Wilcox) to approve the April 5th minutes with corrections. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion (Fuehrer/Brockman) to move Gordy Wipperfurth to the Chairman seat of the Plan Commission, to appoint Terry Rickaby to the Plan Commission, and renew Rob Borski's term. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion (McDonald/Peterson) to approve the CSM for Lloyd Reiman Living Trust, Parcel 1800167 at 3420 15th Street S, Wisconsin Rapids (Intersection of Church Avenue and 28th Street). Motion passed unanimously.

Jeff Manor was representing those that live in the Nepco Lake District. The main roads are plowed in the winter as they are town roads, but the small private roads are not plowed. Lengthy discussion ensued. Supervisor Brockman expressed concerns over the condition of the roads, the number of concrete driveways, and the placement of the private utilities. Chairman Fuehrer explained that the Town would be open to entertaining the idea but would not allow any cost to be encountered by the Town. Mr. Manor will discuss this further with the HOA.

Kasten Kester provided the Road Crew update. The road limits will be coming off tomorrow.

Motion (McDonald/Brockman) to pay bills. Motion passed unanimously.

The next town board meeting will be Wednesday May 3rd at 6:00 p.m. in the town office.

The per diem approval will be reviewed at the next meeting.

Motion (McDonald/Wilcox) to adjourn. Motion passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 6:53 p.m.
