

TOWN OF SARATOGA
An Ordinance Establishing Conditions for Maintaining a Class B Beer/Liquor License in the Town of Saratoga

The Town Board of the Town of Saratoga, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Due to the limited number of Class B Beer/Liquor licenses available within the Town of Saratoga, and in addition to all other grounds for revocation, suspension, or non-renewal of a Class B Beer/Liquor license permitted under Wisconsin Statute §125.12 or otherwise permitted by any state or local laws, the following shall constitute a basis for the Town to suspend, revoke or refuse the renewal of the license in accordance with Wisconsin Statute §125.12(2)(b), or any amendments thereto:

- (A) Failure to commence the sale of fermented malt beverages or intoxicating liquor within 120-days of the issuance of any license to sell fermented malt beverages or intoxicating liquors.
- (B) Failure to remain open for business for a period of at least 120 days during any 180-day period, except that where the licensed premise is operated in connection with a seasonal business, it may be closed during the closed season of such seasonal business.
- (C) Town Board, in its sole discretion, may waive the time requirement under (A) and (B) above in the event of catastrophic destruction of the licensee's premises, however, such waiver shall only extend the time requirements for a period reasonably necessary for the reconstruction of the licensed premises.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
